- Complaints have been received concerning the bin store at the Jug & Glass flats on East Lane. A solution has now been found
- Conservation Area – particularly the High Street. NSDC Officers have made a site visit today – awaiting update.
- Changes to planning system will come into force on October 31st. Planning applications will be split into two categories – Schedule 1 (mainly houses) will be decided by officers. Schedule 2 – (listed buildings and larger applications) could be decided by committee

- Robin Hood Colts – Pete Dobson, Chair
Pete gave an overview of the club including plans to alter the Clubhouse. There are currently 19 teams from under 7s to under 18s and an adult team – in excess of 250 children and 40 adults.
The Parish Council is fully supportive of the plans and will help in any way.
 - Jubilee Park Play Area Upgrade
The grant application has been submitted. Preferred quote has been agreed.
There is money in the Parish Council reserves to pay for the works, subject to reimbursement from the grant application. Councillors unanimously approved proceeding with the project subject to the Clerk establishing grants can be awarded retrospectively. **Clerk to make enquiries with NSDC**
 - Memorial Wood/Edwinstowe Oaks – Update
Approximately 12 residents attended the consultation on 16th May 2026. It was agreed the plan moving forward would be the creation of a friends of group to oversee the area and its management moving forward and to

keep it as a private reserve managed for wildlife and not people. The Parish Council have offered support but will not be part of the ongoing management of the woodland. The group is waiting to hear from the Land Agent at Thoresby Estates concerning the lease.

- iv. Car Park Relining and Electrical Works – Update
Lining is now complete. Electrical works scheduled for later this year due to delay in delivery of spare parts.
